- **Internship** or **study**?
- When is the **right time**?
- Are my **language skills** sufficient?
- How do I find an **exchange programm**?
- How do high is the **organizational effort**?
- What do I have to consider regarding **finances**?

3. Exchange Program Europe: Erasmus+



- Internationalization of the higher education sector
- 33 participating program countries within Europe
- Partner countries outside Europe

- Study or internship at a partner university/ institution
- Duration of study 3-12 months per study cycle

- Tuition fee waiver at the host university
- Mobility grant: depending on the country of destination, between 330 and 450 € (for internships between 435 and 555 €) per month

- Deadline: January 31st

4. Exchange Program overseas

- Exchange programs with partner universities or ISEP International
- Duration of study 3 -12 months
- No or reduced tuition fees
- Application deadline for Northern Hemisphere: **November 15**
- Application deadline for Southern Hemisphere: **July 15**



5. Internships abroad

An internship abroad can be integrated into your studies in many ways.

- short
- more flexible
- use your theoretical knowledge in practice
- Plus on the CV
- Funding opportunities (Erasmus+ Placement, Promos...)

7. Certificate of Intercultural Competence

- a recognition of your **intercultural commitment**
- a formal proof of your **intercultural competence**
- an additional certificate you can include in your **future applications**

Anyone who is enrolled as a student or doctoral candidate at the TU Braunschweig can apply.



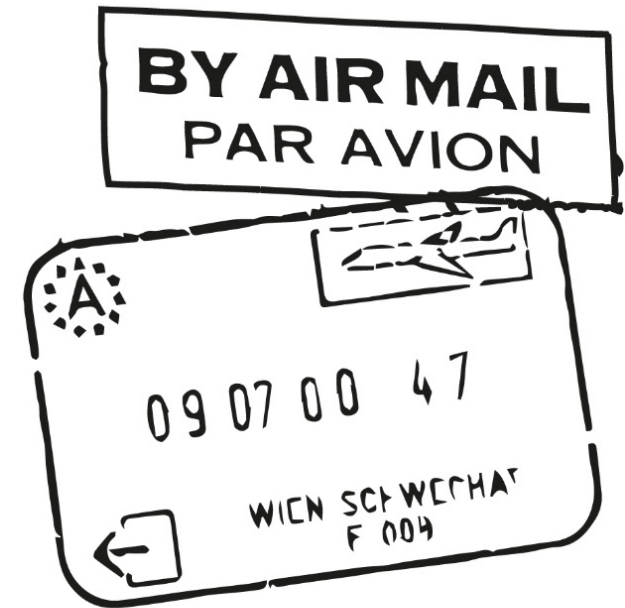
